Meeting with the EC in Brussels (4 June 2009)

On June 4th, 2009, I-VLab had the pleasure to receive in its headquarters in Brussels, Gerald Santucci, Head of Unit Networked Enterprise & RFID (DG INFSO) and Cristina Martinez, Coordinator of Future Internet Enterprise Systems (FInES) cluster (DG INFSO), who met the representatives of poles and the I-VLab management. This meeting was the opportunity to report to G. Santucci and C. Martinez the various activities planned in INTEROP-VLab which had been presented to the General Assembly the day after.

Afterwards, G. Santucci has confirmed his full support to the I-VLab initiatives. He sent a letter in April (available [here](#)) to congratulate the work done during the Interop NoE project and now in the frame of INTEROP-VLab.

Besides, the decision to create on the I-VLab platform a [repository](#) of public deliverables in the EI domain produced by funded EC projects, obviously demonstrates the attention of the EC for I-VLab.

This repository in free access will be largely publicized and will offer to the research community a "living memory" of the projects results.
