Main decisions of the 4th General Assembly

The 4th General Assembly (20 May 2010, Brussels) reviewed and approved the activities presented by the different bodies of INTEROP-VLab and took the following main decisions:

- Appointment of University of Helsinki as representative of the INTEROP North Pole
- Election of the Board of Directors (President, Treasurer and Secretary)
- Approval of the IVEC (INTEROP-VLab Event Cycle)
- Approval to continue to support the FInES Cluster
- Preparation of the creation of new Poles (Romania, Black Sea Universities Network)
- Implementation of the scientific, education and standardization activities
- Development of the Task Forces and Thematic Groups activities

ICT 2010 : the Networking Session proposed by INTEROP-VLab is selected

INTEROP-VLab has been appointed by EC to coordinate a Networking Session on "FInES in Networked SMEs" at the ICT 2010 event. This session is the result of the merger of 3 topics: "Future Internet for Business Innovation in Networked SMEs" proposed by INTEROP-VLab (BE), "Future Internet Enterprise Systems" proposed by NTUA (GR), and "Enterprise Interoperability Management certification" proposed by Fraunhofer IPK (DE).

The goal of this session is to address the following questions:

- How to introduce FInES into networked SMEs at an affordable cost, and how to facilitate adoption by potential users,
- How to support the development of FInES through a Science Base for Enterprise Interoperability.
- How to facilitate the adoption of FInES solutions by SMEs by introducing certification capability for enterprise interoperability in cooperation with other SMEs.

Three speakers will introduce the subject and present relevant approaches, followed by a "Knowledge café" in order to elaborate recommendations, develop and determine the conditions for the successful utilisation of FInES solutions by SMEs.
