### Preparation of a project proposal in the FI-PPP call Phase 2



The Management of I-VLab is trying to launch a common project involving all the pole members. In 2010, a project was set up in the frame of the objective 1.8, Future Internet (FI) "Use Case scenarios and early trials (Phase 1)". The project was not selected. It was decided to prepare a second project to the same call but 2nd phase (deadline October 2012). The principle is the same: each pole proposes an ecosystem composed of a network of SMEs, one or two research centers, one or two IT providers belonging to the pole. The goal is to determine the requirement for FI based on the running of each local ecosystem and also for the interaction between ecosystems. The project will be supported by the main actors of the FI domain. A meeting will be organized in Brussels on December 21<sup>st</sup> with the Pole representatives, who will present the ecosystem of their Pole, and the actors of FI.
