- How to facilitate the adoption of FInES solutions by SMEs by introducing certification capability for Enterprise Interoperability in cooperation with other SMEs?, by Frank-Walter Jäkel (IPK Fraunhofer)

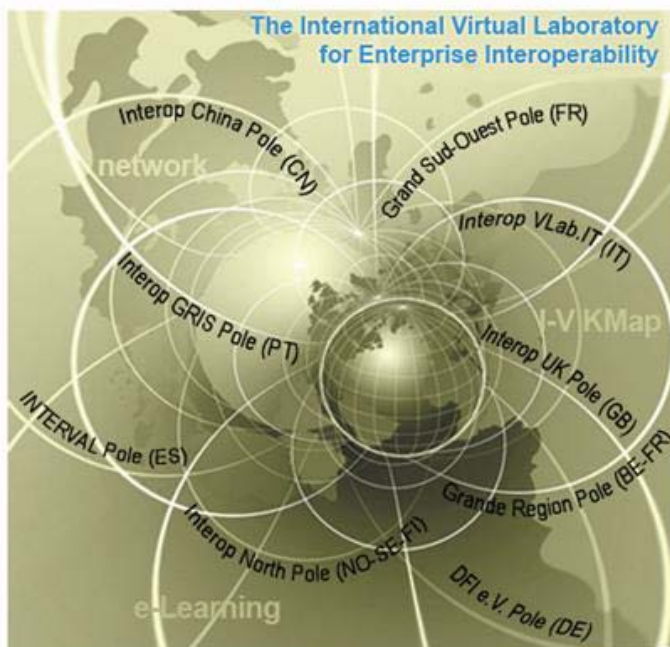
Then all the participants debated during the knowledge café from which a synthesis of the viewpoints and ideas was presented at the end of the session.
