High quality research papers and case studies are invited to be submitted through the following link:

All submissions must be original work and must not have been published elsewhere and must not be currently under consideration by any other conferences or journals. Submitting a paper means that, if the paper is accepted, at least one author will pay the registration fee and attend the conference to present the paper.

Each submission should meet the following requirements:

- No more than 8 pages (including references, illustrations, and appendices) for research track and application / industry / education tracks
- No more than 3 pages (including references, illustrations, and appendices) for Working-In-Progress track.

Awards

ICSS 2015 will offer one Best Paper award and one Best Student Paper award. The best papers are selected from the accepted papers of the research track.
